The National Football League, or as it is more widely known, the NFL, has a lot of teams, players, and coaches.





NORTH KOREA TRIED TO HACK INFORMATION FROM PFIZER ABOUT THE VACCINE.



It's called **SLEEP PARALYSIS!!!**




What is sleep paralysis?



Walter Diemer is the inventor of bubble gum!




Since 1928, bubblegum has been a favorite among lots of people and still will be for decades to come. Let's hear some amazing facts about bubblegum!





•The top US infectious diseases expert says the country may be able to vaccinate many Americans by the middle or end of summer.


•More US states are loosening Covid-19 restrictions, even as experts warn the country it is still not in the clear — especially as variants spread.

On August 20th of 1920, a man named Walter Camp created a sport called football which is old but evolving. It's a popular sport that can be watched in person, on TV, or on apps. There's a new event called the Super Bowl where if a team wins then they win Super Bowl trophies or rings and the first team who won was the Green Bay Packers.




There are 32 teams in the NFL, each trying for the Super Bowl win at the end of the season. An NFL rookie earns a minimum of \$420,000 a year. A 30-second commercial in the 2011 Super Bowl cost around \$3 million. More than 100 million people watch the Super Bowl every year. The NFL's Highest-Paid Players 2020: **Bosa** Tops With \$44 Million, **Mahomes** Sits Out. Los Angeles Chargers defensive end **Joey Bosa** cashed in this summer with a \$135 million deal.

How to play: The game is played using a spherical ball of 68–70 cm (27–28 in) circumference, known as the football (or **soccer** ball). Two teams of eleven players each compete to get the ball into the other team's goal (between the posts and under the bar), thereby scoring a goal.



A: Nothing, we don't really have a goal





